

# LEARNING NEW WORDS

There are lots of ways to memorise new words. You need to find the method that works best for you. Here are a few suggestions:

- ❑ **Vocabulary lists:** Take a sheet of paper and draw two columns (French words/English words). Cover one column, then the other and test yourself. Keep on testing yourself until you know all the words without hesitating.
- ❑ **Flashcards:** Making your own flashcards is easy: simply write the French word on one side and the English word on the other. You can remove the cards that you always get right.
- ❑ **Copying:** Some people find it easier to remember words if they copy them down until they can write them from memory.
- ❑ **Word association:** The word for tooth is "dent". If you think of the English word "dentist", remembering "dent" becomes easy.
- ❑ **Getting somebody to test you:** Why not ask a parent or a friend to test you with your vocabulary? It will help you spot the things you know well and the things you still need to work on.

When memorising new words, you need to look at:

- ❑ **how to spell them:** Spelling is important! You may want to try and copy a word several times to memorise it;
- ❑ **how to say them:** Try saying them or ask someone to read them to you;
- ❑ **the gender of the words:** You need to know whether the word is masculine (starting with "le") or feminine ("la");
- ❑ **any special characters:** Accents in French are important because they can change the sound of the letter.
